Quality of Life

The people of the Miracle Mile area wish to live a healthy, stable, and productive lifestyle. To achieve and maintain a stable environment for all parties, and a pleasurable experience for all people that use the area. To provide quality education for the people of Wyoming on natural resource uses, now and in the future.

Production

Profitability from livestock, recreation, crops, wildlife, minerals, water, power, and real estate.

Landscape

We wish to develop a diversity of trees, shrubs, and grasses along the stream bank area. A great complexity of grass communities with inter-mixed trees and shrubs from the river area to the uplands. Healthy complex soils with clean water and no erosion. Large open areas for use by all parties. Better water distribution for wildlife and livestock.
