I am in receipt of your letter of March 11 in which you ask the following question:
"Do Wyoming Soil Conservation Districts have the authority under their State law to carry out, maintain, and operate the works of improvement proposed in Public Law 566?"

H. B. 103, now being H.E.A. 43, and which will appear as Chapter 71, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1955, in my opinion gives the Soil Conservation Districts authority to cooperate with the United States, or any of its agencies, under Public Law 566.
