Your office has asked for a further clarification of my opinion to you, dated March 15, 1955, in regard to H.E.A. 43, which will appear as Chapter 71, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1955.

It is my opinion that Soil Conservation Districts in Wyoming, by virtue of the recent amendment to the Wyoming Soil Conservation District law (which I have quoted above) are authorized to cooperate with the United States by acting as "local organizations" as that term is defined in Public Law 566, 83rd Congress.
