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

FIND YOUR PATH TO DISPUTE RESOLUTION THROUGH MEDIATION

WHY USE MEDIATION:

- Save time and money
- Reach common ground
- Resolve issues
- Avoid litigation
- Maintain relationships



WHEN TO USE MEDIATION:

- You've tried to negotiate
- Personality conflicts
- Existing miscommunication
- A desire for resolution exists



HOW IT WORKS:

Ground rules are laid to keep the process productive and any questions are answered by the mediator. Both parties are given a chance to tell their side of the story. The mediator will help identify main issues and help explore options for resolution. When common ground is found, an agreement is written to meet both parties' needs.



WHAT IS MEDIATION:

Mediation is a voluntary and confidential process which fosters open and straightforward communication between disputing parties. A trained mediator helps these parties explore available options and reach a conclusion through mutually agreed upon solutions. The mediator takes a neutral position and does not advocate for either party. The mediator does not determine who is right or wrong and is not a decision-maker.
