RE: Wyoming Conservation Commission -
Proposed Rules and Regulations for
Reclamation Standards

Dear Larry:

Please be advised that the Wyoming Conservation Commission may promulgate rules and regulations setting forth land reclamation standards and specifications in accordance with sound and established conservation methods and practices, which affect land or resources within our state. Authority to set up and adopt such standards lies within the purview of the Wyoming Conservation Districts Law (W.S. 11-234, et seq.) and specifically Sections 11-238(A) (rule making authority), 11-238 (legislative policy and purpose of Act), and 11-235(h) (definition of "Conservation").
