The first goal is to inform those attending about the current drought conditions and fire issues throughout the state along with information pertaining to disaster assistance program status and requirements. The second goal is to garner input from attendees on how the Wyoming Department of Agriculture can best serve producers of the State during these trying circumstances.

The first meeting will be held in Newcastle on Monday, July 9th at 2 p.m. in the Weston County Natural Resource District building. The Weston County Natural Resource building is located at 1225 Washington Blvd. #3 in Newcastle, Wyo.

The second meeting will be held in Pinedale on Wednesday, July 11th at 2 p.m. in the Sublette County Conservation District Office. The Sublette County Conservation District Office is located at 1625 W. Pine in Pinedale, Wyo.

The third and final meeting will be held in Cody on Friday, July 13th at 2 p.m. in the Park County Courthouse. The Park County Courthouse is located at 1002 Sheridan in Cody, Wyo.
