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**RESTRICTIONS/PRECAUTIONS:**

- Do not enter or allow worker entry during the restricted-entry interval (REI) of 24 hours.
- Use only on fields in production of alfalfa or clover seed.
- Do not make more than 1 applications per crop per year.
- Do not harvest seed until at least 4 days after application.
- Refer to spray drift information contained in the "Directions for Use" section of the container label for proper application to avoid off-target movement. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas.
- Do not apply by ground equipment within 25 ft. or by air within 75 ft. of lakes; reservoirs; rivers; permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds; estuaries; and commercial fish ponds.
- Alfalfa seed may not be distributed for human consumption or animal feed.
- No portion of the alfalfa or clover seed plant, including but not limited to green chop, hay, pellets, meal, whole seed, cracked seed, roots, bulbs, leaves and seed screenings may be used or distributed for food or feed purposes.
- Do not graze current year's treated alfalfa or clover seed crops.
- All alfalfa and clover seed screenings must be disposed of in such a way that they cannot be distributed or used for human food or animal feed. The seed conditioner must keep records of screening disposal for 3 years from the date of disposal and shall furnish the records to the director immediately upon request. Conditioner disposal records must consist of documentation of on-farm disposal, disposal at a controlled dumpsite, incinerator, composter, or other equivalent disposal site and must include the lot numbers, amount of material disposed of, its grower(s), and the date of disposal.
- Alfalfa and clover seed must bear a seed tag or container label which forbids use of the seed for human consumption or animal feed. The grower is responsible for notifying processing plants of any treated seed crop.
